464 patients in GAinS By the

end of February, 464 patients with faecal peritonitis (195) and community-acquired pneumonia (269) had been recruited to GAinS. Recruitment numbers for GAinS and GenOSept, for individual centres are shown below:

GenOSept Recruitment to

GenOSept Europe-wide has exceeded 1555 patients as more countries and centres come on-stream. More than 100 patients are being recruited each month! Almost all GAinS centres in the UK have also joined the GenOSept project and receive 100 euros for every patient recruited to GenOSept/GAinS.

Reimbursement for GenOSept patients

UK and other European centres have been receiving reimbursement for patients recruited to GenOSept. The first payment is made after the 1st 5 patients have been enrolled and from then on payments are made on a quarterly basis.

Data Quality Assurance (QA)

The joint GAinS/GenOSept projects are being actively subjected to a QA programme to ensure accuracy and

completeness of the eCRF data. Alex Smith and Paula Hutton, based in Oxford, have reviewed hundreds of eCRFs from across the UK and Europe! Errors or omissions create alerts which are used to generate email data queries. More than 2,000 queries have been sent but only about a quarter of these having been resolved so far. Do contact us if anything needs clarification. Please respond to the data queries as soon as possible so that the data set of patients recruited to date can be used in the interim analysis in July/August this year.

UK Clinical Research Network (UKCRN)

UKCRN has included the GenOSept study into its NIHR Clinical Research Network Portfolio. This means that each study centre may be eligible to claim some funding to support the GenOSept research activity at that site. Please do contact your local Research and Development department to ask if you may be entitled to some financial support from the network to support your work on the GenOSept study. Data analysis strategy

A genome-wide association analysis will be performed on the initial cohort of 1800 GenOSept patients beginning July/August 2008. Replication and fine mapping will be undertaken on a subsequent cohort of 700-800 patients.

Patient recruitment for GenOSept will end at the end of December 2008. Recruitment to GAinS will continue for 2–3 more years.
